MEASLES

Measles is featuring currently in Coronation Street. As you may have seen a baby who has not been fully vaccinated has become ill and has had to be hospitalised. Last year, there was a measles outbreak in Croydon with more than 40 cases confirmed between January and August.

As children develop, they are exposed to many risks, one of these risks being infections. Most of these will cause mild illnesses. However, despite great medical advances, infections can still result in severe illnesses, disability and at times death.

Everyone who is not immune is at risk of contracting the virus and passing it on to others.

Please ensure that your children are fully vaccinated. If you are in doubt, please speak to your GP or Practice Nurse and they will be able to advise if you child has missed or is due vaccinations

DOCTORLINK

The practice is introducing Doctorlink, which is a free app where you can check your symptoms and be guided towards the right care, whether it's booking an appointment with your NHS GP, directing you to your nearest pharmacy or advising on home care.

SUMMARY CARE RECORDS (SCR'S)

Your SCR contains information on medicines you are taking, all allergies you suffer from and any bad reactions to medicine that you have previously experienced. More information can be added to your SCR which can include long term health conditions, relevant medical history, health care preferences, your personal preference, immunisations and specific sensitive information.

If you would like more information or you would like your SCR to be updated please ask one of the receptionists for an information leaflet and form.

LINK WORKER

Aliya a Social Prescribing Link Worker has recently joined the practice undertaking varying roles and responsibilities. She is non-clinical and the GP can refer you to see her in her Wednesday afternoon session. She can help with befriending, disability support, employment advice, loneliness and isolation, volunteering etc. If when you next see one of the GP's that think you might benefit from an appointment with Aliya please let the GP know and if appropriate he will ask you to make an appointment at reception.
